## Accommodation

Prices in the Slavija hotel \*\*:

Single bed room, Bed & Buffet Breakfast ..... €35 (each additional meal €8)

Double bed room, Bed & Breakfast ..... €25 (each additional meal €8)

Hotel Slavija is in the center of the Slavija Square, the last station of the official bus going from the Belgrade Airport. The official bus costs around €2,5 and it is recommended as the cheapest way to get to the Slavija Square.

The Belgrade Train and Bus Stations are ten minutes walk down the street from the Slavija Square. If you come by bus or train you could take tram or bus up the street.

Offered prices are lower than official ones in the hotel Slavija and **the costs should be paid to the organizers, upon arrival**. Participants are free to choose any other accommodation, with €10 entry-fee paid to the organizers.

There is a choice of hotels of higher quality near by, such as Slavija Lux on the other side of the street (the discount price for participants €80 B&B in a single room). We find our offer to be the optimal for the center of the town, 2 minutes walking distance from the competition place, and 5 minutes walking distance from the Chess Club Beograd Beopublikum.
